Planning Commission Resolution #PC 2018-07 recommending to the City Council the adoption of Ordinance No. 892 approving Zone Change No. 2018-080 to amend the Official Zoning Map to change the zoning designation for the property located at 8000 Bell Gardens Avenue ("Project Site) from R-1 (Single Family Residential) to R-3 (High Density Residential) / RPDD (Residential Planned Development District) overlay to the City Council;
