Nomination papers will be available on **July 13, 2020 through August 7, 2020**. The deadline to file Nomination Papers is **Friday, August 7, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.** If nomination documents for an incumbent are not filed by 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2020, the nomination period shall be extended until Wednesday, August 12, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. for persons other than the incumbent.
