On September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed Assembly Bill 361 ("AB 361"), which was effective immediately and amends Government Code section 54953 to allow a local legislative body to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to observe and to address the local legislative body. Pursuant to AB 361, please be advised that members of the Senior Citizen Commission may participate in meetings telephonically. The public may view the meeting and participate in public remotely.
