NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on January 24, 2021, the City Council of the City of Bell Gardens, California, introduced Ordinance No. 921 entitled:


**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELL GARDENS,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE BELL GARDENS MUNICIPAL
CODE CHAPTER 9.40 'SIGNS,' SECTION 9.04.065
'ELECTRONIC BILLBOARD REGULATIONS AND
STANDARDS,' REGARDING BILLBOARD DISTANCE
REQUIREMENTS**

The proposed ordinance would amend the Bell Gardens Municipal Code Chapter 9.40, Section 9.40.065 by allowing flexibility for electronic billboards closer than 150 feet to a residential use as long as evidence of no light impacts are found. The amendment will provide the City Council with the opportunity to review and approve electronic billboards that are proposed within 150 feet of a residential zone or use.
