ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The funds will be paid directly to the qualified students after proof of eligibility has been provided.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

 - Must be a High School Senior.
 - Must provide **official** high school transcripts.
 - Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above.
 - Must submit a completed application and essay.
- *Proof of residency will be provided through the official High School transcript.
