The funds will be paid directly to the qualified students after proof of eligibility has been provided.

- Must be a *Bell Gardens resident.
- Must be a High School Senior.
- Must provide <u>official</u> high school transcripts.

- Must submit a completed application and essay.
- *Proof of residency will be provided through the official High School transcript.
