## **ORDINANCE NO. 931**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on April 10, 2023, the City Council of the City of Bell Gardens, California, adopted Ordinance No. 931 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL GARDENS, CALIFORNIA ADDING CHAPTER 9.71 "ART IN PUBLIC PLACES" TO TITLE 9 (ZONING AND PLANNING REGULATIONS) OF THE BELL GARDENS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING PUBLIC ART REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS WITHIN BELL GARDENS

The adopted ordinance would expand the opportunities for residents and visitors to experience artistic, historic, and cultural aspects of the City through the placement of artwork associated with new and revitalization development.

The adopted ordinance has been written to require applicants of proposed certain new development projects to install approved artwork in conjunction with entitled projects, donate artwork or contribute an in-lieu contribution equal to one percent (1%) of the total building valuation on-site to the City.
