



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BELL RECOMMENDING APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF ADDING AN ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE ELEMENT TO THE BELL GARDENS GENERAL PLAN AND ALL RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, the Planning Commission of the City of Bell Gardens will conduct a public hearing to consider adoption of Resolution #PC No. 2024-09 finding that a proposed Final “Draft” of a new Environmental Justice Element (City-wide) added to the Bell Gardens General Plan is consistent with the General Plan and State Law.

DATE OF HEARING: Wednesday, April 17, 2024.

TIME OF HEARING: 5:15 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible.

LOCATION: City Council Chambers, 7100 Garfield Avenue, Bell Gardens, CA 90201

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATIONS: In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Res. Code § 21000 *et seq.*) a Negative Declaration (ND) was prepared, and it was determined that the project would not have a significant effect on the environment. The ND is available for public review from Monday April 8, 2024, through Monday, May 8, 2024, on the city’s website.

INVITATION TO BE HEARD/PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: The public hearing will be held before the City of Bell Gardens City Council at 7100 Garfield Avenue, Bell Gardens, CA 90201 on Wednesday, April 17, 2024, at 5:15 p.m. The public may attend the meeting in person or may view the meeting online. The meeting will be recorded and live streamed on the City's website at <https://www.bellgardens.org/i-want-to/watch-citycommission-meetings>. Public comments for the public hearing are limited to three (3) minutes per person. Members of the public can access and participate in the meetings as follows:

IN-PERSON: Members of the public can provide in-person comments at the podium in the Council Chamber. The Council Chamber will have seating available for members of the public to attend the meeting in-person, subject to capacity limits. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes for each designated public comment period(s) per speaker unless a different time is announced by the presiding chair. Speakers who wish to address the Planning Commission should do so by submitting a "Public Comment Card" card by 5:15 p.m. for all other designated public comment periods as listed.
