1. <u>GENERAL MOTION TO WAIVE FULL READING AND APPROVE</u> ORDINANCES BY TITLE ONLY PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 36934

In order to expedite the conduct of business at City Council meetings, California State Law (California Government Code Section 36934) allows Ordinances to be read by title if a majority of the legislative body supports the motion to waive the full reading.

Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that the City Council approve a general motion to waive full reading and approve Ordinances by title only pursuant to California Government Code Section 36934.

Recommendation:

3. WARRANT REGISTERS AND WIRE TRANSFERS

Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that the City Council receive and file the warrant registers dated 09/26/17 and 10/03/17.

4. CLAIM REJECTION

Claim Rejection

Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that the City Council reject the following claim and the claimant and/or their representative be notified:

Viveros, Maria v. City of Bell Gardens (DOE 8/10/17; DOR 8/21/17)

The City's general liability claims administrator, Carl Warren & Company, recommends that this claim be rejected. The claimant, subject to certain exceptions, shall have up to six months to file a court action subsequent to the City Council's rejection.

5. SIDE LETTER AGREEEMENT WITH BELL GARDENS CITY EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

6. ACCEPTANCE OF THE GYM/BASKETBALL COURT HARDWOOD FLOOR REPLACEMENT PROJECT AT THE RECREATION SERVICES BUILDING – C.I.P. NO. 3839

On June 26, 2017, the City Council awarded the construction contract of the Gym/Basketball Court Hardwood Floor Replacement Project to Roy's Flooring Inc. The project was completed on September 18, 2017. The Project Manager and Inspector conducted their final inspection on September 19, 2017 and determined that the project was completed satisfactorily and in conformance with the project's plans and specifications. Therefore, staff is recommending that the City Council accept the construction contract as complete and authorize staff to file the Notice of Completion.

Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that the City Council by motion:

- Accept the construction contract for the Gym/Basketball Court Hardwood Floor Replacement Project as complete, and
- 2. Authorize staff to file the Notice of Completion.
