

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The City of Bell Gardens has completed an Initial Study for the following project in accordance with City and State of California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines:

Project Title: The City of Bell Gardens Environmental Justice Element

**Project Location:** Citywide

**Project Description:** The proposed project includes the adoption of the General Plan Environmental Justice ("EJ") Element consistent with state law. The EJ Element addresses and aims to minimize the adverse effects of environmental hazards to create a healthy environment for all people, especially those groups, populations, and communities who had been impacted by pollution. The aim of EJ is to reduce burdens for communities experiencing adverse effects, promote meaningful participation of those communities in all phases of the environmental and land use decision making process, and providing meaningful consideration of recommendations from populations and communities most impacted by pollution into environmental and land use decisions.

Negative Declaration: An initial study of environmental impacts was prepared pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14 ("CEQA Guidelines"), Section 15063. A Negative Declaration of Environmental Impacts is proposed for this project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15367. The public review and comment period for the Negative Declaration begins on April 9, 2024, and ends at 6:00 PM on May 9, 2024.

**Public Hearings:** A public hearing to consider the proposed EJ Element and Negative Declaration is scheduled before the Planning Commission on Wednesday, April 17, 2024, at 5:15 PM. The meeting will be held in the Council Chambers, 7100 Garfield Avenue, Bell Gardens, CA 90201. A public hearing regarding adoption of the EJ Element and the Negative Declaration will be considered by the City Council on Monday, May 13, 2024, at 6:00 PM, in the Council Chambers, 7100 Garfield Avenue, Bell Gardens, CA 90201.
