ORDINANCE SUMMARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 8, 2024, the City Council of the City of Bell Gardens, California, introduced Ordinance No. 942 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELL GARDENS AMENDING TITLE 5 (BUSINESS LICENSES, REGULATIONS AND TAXES) OF THE BELL GARDENS MUNICIPAL CODE TO RESTRICT THE NUMBER OF BUSINESS REGULATORY PERMITS FOR CANNABIS RETAIL BUSINESSES

The ordinance would restrict permissible business regulatory permits for commercial cannabis activity within Bell Gardens to no more than seven (7).

Proposed Ordinance Summary:

The ordinance has been written so that may only be a maximum of seven active business regulatory permits for cannabis retail use at any given time. A cannabis retail business that has had its business regulatory permit revoked or has not started operations within a year of receiving the business regulatory permit is not considered active.
