## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BELL GARDENS APPROVING CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 2024-019 TO AUTHORIZE A NEW MICROWAVE STATION TO BE USED AS A WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITY AT 6326 GAGE AVENUE, BELL GARDENS, CA 90201 (6330-019-801)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, the Planning Commission of the City of Bell Gardens will conduct a public hearing to consider approval of Conditional Use Permit No. 2024-019 to authorize the development of a new microwave station to be used as a wireless communication facility on an existing Southern California Edison (SCE) transmission tower located at 6326 Gage Avenue, located within Zone O-S (Open Space/Parks) and within the O-S (Open Space/Parks) General Plan Land Use Designation.

**DATE OF HEARING:** Wednesday, June 19, 2024.

**TIME OF HEARING:** 5:15 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATIONS:** In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Res. Code § 21000 et seq.) and CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.), staff recommends that action on the proposed conditional use permit be found categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Class 1 Cal. Code Regs., Tit. 14, § 15301 (Existing Facilities)(minor alteration of an existing public or private structure).

**INVITATION TO BE HEARD/PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:** The public hearing will be held before the City of Bell Gardens Planning Commission at 7100 Garfield Avenue, Bell Gardens, CA 90201 on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, at 5:15 p.m. The public may attend the meeting in person or may view the meeting online. Public comments for the public hearing are limited to three (3) minutes per person. Members of the public can access and participate in the meetings as follows:
