Ordinance Summary

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 22, 2024, the City Council of the City of Bell Gardens, California, introduced Ordinance No. 943 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL GARDENS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 9.04 (DEFINITIONS), CHAPTER 9.12 (COMMERCIAL ZONES), CHAPTER 9.14 (INDUSTRIAL ZONE), CHAPTER 9.20 (SPECIAL USES AND APPLICABLE STANDARDS), AND CHAPTER 9.38 (PARKING AND LOADING (OFF STREET)) OF TITLE 9 (ZONING AND PLANNING REGULATIONS) OF THE BELL GARDENS MUNICIPAL CODE TO REGULATE VEHICLE PARKING AND STORAGE FOR AUTOMOBILE REPAIR USES

The proposed ordinance would regulate off-street vehicle parking and storage for automobile repair uses.


Proposed Ordinance Summary:

Ordinance No. 943 proposes to amend BGMC Title 9 (Zoning and Planning Regulations) to require that automobile repair uses provide and maintain adequate off-street parking and loading facilities, to encourage private property development and improvement for storage and queuing purposes and promote the evenly balanced use of available shared public right-of-way parking. The proposed ordinance would provide regulations and alternatives to accommodate off-street parking and storage for customers queuing for repair and vehicles.

The City Council introduced the ordinance for public posting with the following vote:
