"TOWAWAY NO PARKING" ZONE FROM 6:00 AM TO 6:00 PM AT 7945 SCOUT AVENUE TO FACILITATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

AT JOHN ANSON FORD PARK

**DATE:** August 15, 2024

#### RECOMMENDATION:

It is staff's recommendation that the Traffic and Safety Commission approve for City Council consideration the installation of 80 feet of temporary 'Tow-Away No Parking' from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, fronting 7945 Scout Avenue to facilitate construction activities at John Anson Ford Park.

#### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

Staff received a request from the John Anson Ford Park Regional Aquatics Center Improvements (Aquatics Center) contractor for a temporary "Towaway No Parking" zone at 7945 Scout Avenue to facilitate the entry and exit of large trucks to the construction zone, as part of the pool demolition and construction activities. The temporary restriction would be removed after construction is completed, which is currently anticipated by Fall 2025.

On July 2, 2024, the Traffic and Safety Commission approved staff's recommendation to seek City Council approval for the installation of 105 feet of temporary 'Tow-Away No Parking' restrictions. However, after further assessment, staff determined that only 80 feet of temporary 'Tow-Away No Parking' restrictions are necessary since there is an existing red curb measuring 25 feet starting at the northeast corner of Gotham Street and Scout Avenue.

#### **EXISTING CONDITIONS:**

The City's Traffic Engineer completed a site investigation of the location to confirm existing conditions of the site and construction activity impacts.

#### **INVESTIGATION AND DISCUSSION:**

The purpose of the temporary "Towaway No Parking" zone is due to the wide turning radius of large trucks hauling debris and materials out of or into the construction site. Currently, vehicles are parked on the west side of Scout Avenue from the Gotham Avenue

intersection going north. Approximately 2-3 parking spaces would be impacted during daytime hours but overnight parking would be allowed.

The temporary "Towaway No Parking" zone would occupy approximately 80 feet from the red curb at the northeast corner of Gotham Street and Scout Avenue, northerly past the property at 7945 Scout Avenue. Two signs are recommended to be installed with the noted times and with "Begin" and "End" signs mounted below the "Towaway No Parking" sign.

Staff recommends the installation of the signs and posts as noted for the "Towaway No Parking" zone.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

After a review of the existing site conditions, the City's Traffic Engineer has determined the installation of a 80 ft. long temporary 'Towaway No Parking' zone fronting 7945 Scout Avenue is necessary to facilitate construction activities for the Aquatics Center.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

\$500 for materials and labor from the Street Maintenance Account
