CITY OF BELL GARDENS Ordinance Summary

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on October 14, 2024, the City Council of the City of Bell Gardens, California, introduced Ordinance No. 951 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL GARDENS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 9.04 (DEFINITIONS) AND CHAPTER 9.40 (SIGNS) OF TITLE 9 (ZONING AND PLANNING REGULATIONS) OF THE BELL GARDENS MUNICIPAL CODE TO REGULATE ELECTRONIC DISPLAY SIGNS

The proposed ordinance would add regulations for electronic display signs on fuel and electricity dispensing pumps for motor vehicles and for electric vehicles.

Proposed Ordinance Summary:

Ordinance No. 951 proposes to amend Bell Gardens Municipal Code Title 9 (Zoning and Planning Regulations) to add regulations for certain electronic display signs, provide location restrictions, light pollution control, content guidelines, maintenance requirements, and safety mechanisms, among other things, to balance the benefits of modern advertising technologies and the local economy.
